

WCG Finds Inspiration in a special kind of partnership

A program of the Lions Foundation of Canada Dog Guides, Canine Vision Canada (CVC) Dog Guides work with Canadians who are blind or visually impaired. The dogs are trained to help clients navigate around obstacles in public areas and help to ensure that their handlers arrive at their destination safely. Graduates of the CVC program have commented that their dog guide partners give them a greater sense of security and confidence while out in public, encouraging them to be more active in their daily routines.

CVC relies entirely on the generosity of individuals, corporations and service clubs to continue its work. Six thousand dollars will sponsor a canine vision guide - this donation is directly responsible for changing an individual's life for the better.

WCG works with people with various disabilities, and we see the difference that a guide dog partner can make in their lives. WCG employees have the advantage of working with fellow employee Judy Keenan (who is visually impaired), and they see the difference that her dog guide partner, Luca, makes in her life. Inspired by this special bond, WCG staff and management came together and raised the full \$6000 that it takes to unite one of these special partnerships. WCG's sponsorship is funding the training of a dog guide set to graduate in February of 2006, being trained by the same trainer as Luca was!
